As of this date we have two seminars scheduled for 2011 , the paint in, the auction and the Christmas party, we need seven classes this year. I would like to get as many teachers submitting classes as we can. If you would like to teach in a definite month , please note this on the submission sheet. When another seminar date has been picked we will set up the months for the workshops. The months open are January, February, May, June. August, September and November.

The class fee for a member is \$15.00 of which SDP will pay \$10.00 per student to the teacher. The maximum student count is 39 and whole day workshops are from 9:00 am (following business meeting) until 4:00 pm. A break for coffee/tea after the meeting, lunch and an afternoon break, if needed, will be given. The teacher will supply, to the Workshop Coordinator, a line drawing, prep instructions, and a one time color photo of the project at least three months prior to the class. Detailed instructions will be given to each student on the day of the class. If this is not an original design, the teacher must indicate the artist's name and the source of the design on the instruction sheet. It is the teacher's responsibility to obtain permission, in writing, when using another artist's design. The teacher absorbs the cost of copy services. If a special surface has to be ordered for the project, this amount will be indicated in advance. If using discontinued colors please list a substitute for that color in your prep instructions. SDP letterhead will be supplied to the teacher in order to request paint from a distributor. If paint is not supplied by a distributor the students will bring their own paint and the chapter will supply a set for class use.

Submissions must be handed in no later that September 20, 2010. GIVE TO ARMANDA EAGAN IN AN ENVELOPE WITH THIS FORM FILLED OUT, PLUS PHOTO(S) OF PROPOSED PROJECT(S). These will be voted on at the October meeting.

You will be notified in November if your project has been picked.

A big THANKS TO Mary Sue, Joanne, and Armanda for their tireless efforts in making this happen.

1st VP, Armanda Eagan, said people were signing for the workshops and wanted people to send in separate checks for each class. Do not combine them. We also need food / raffle sign ups. This will discussed further at the next board meeting.

SEMINARS, Ann Foster was absent. Elaine Russell took the sign ups for the Bobbie Campbell Seminar in July, and told people of the change in dates and meeting place; also requested food sign ups for the 2 day seminar. We will be able to set up on Friday evening at 5 pm at the ARC. Certificates for the seminars and workshops have no expiration date.

held on December 11 at the Halifax Plantation Club House from 11:30 until 3:30. It was decided that we will bring a hand painted or hand-made item for gift exchange. She also asked for door prizes to be donated. Baked Salmon, Roast Pork or Chicken Tuscan was selected as the choice of menu; also a vegetarian entrée will be offered. Cost and ticket info will come at a later date.

PUBLICITY --Francis reported that she is checking out the News Journal, Penny Saver public service ads. for a monthly spot.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE. Paulette Capwell asked for people to think about a person for president and other jobs. She will soon start asking if YOU will help out.

DOOR PRIZES: This needs to be discussed at the next board meeting, along with setting up a hospitality committee. Ways and Means Handles the raffles.

The cabinet needs to be moved again to ARC. Armanda and husband will move it. A motion was made to issue a gift certificate to them for their patience in moving this cabinet. It was passed.

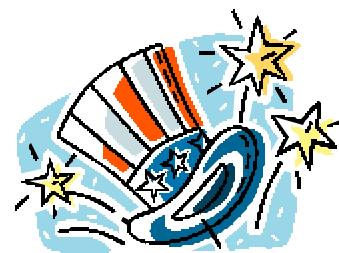
